The next chapters explain the continuum of long-term care services and care coordination across settings. The book's final section covers long-term care community operations, leadership and administration of these services, and legal and ethical challenges.

Changes in the Eighth Edition

This revised edition includes updated statistics throughout and is aligned with the National Association of Long-Term Care Administrator Boards' (NAB) domains of practice health services executives. Several chapters include case studies from *Cases in Population Health and Community Health* by Connie J. Evashwick, ScD, LFACHE Jason S. Turner, PhD casebook, published by Health Administration Press. In this revised edition, chapters are divided into three sections rather than two, and several of the chapter titles have been revised.
